

Banned items

The following items will be refused. They will be returned and/or shutdown and clean-up and evacuation costs will be charged.



Batteries and/or separate Li-ion batteries

We charge a fixed rate of € 500 per battery.



Strongboxes and safes



Household hazardous waste



Non-depolluted engines



Munitions and explosives



Non-depolluted transformers

Transformers free of PCBs are allowed subject to a cleaning certificate.



Storage batteries

Storage batteries should be brought in separately: lead acid batteries



Electronic waste

Only large white goods and depolluted brown goods are accepted. White goods containing refrigerant gasses will be refused. Non-compliant material will be returned and/or shutdown and clean-up and evacuation costs will be charged.



Cars

Non-depolluted cars should be brought in complete (incl. tyres, engine, etc.) and without additional dirt. Depolluted cars for which a destruction certificate has already been issued should be brought in respectively in accordance with VLAREM (Flemish Environmental Permit Regulations) Article 5.2.2.6.4.§2. or Article 84 of the Walloon Government Decree of 23.09.2010, all fluids (air-conditioning, oil, coolant and windscreen washer fluid, etc.), gas tank, battery, catalytic converter, tyres, oil filter having been removed and free of additional dirt.

Banned recipients

The following recipients will be refused. The material will be returned and/or shutdown and clean-up and evacuation costs will be charged.



Small recipients with lid (gas canisters and cylinders)

With lid removed + punctured 2 cm: allowed.



Large recipients if not cleaned (tanks and vats)

Allowed subject to cleaning certificate and/or degasification certificate.

Banned materials

The following materials will be refused. They will be returned and/or shutdown and clean-up and evacuation costs will be charged.



Asbestos (-containing) material

Asbestos (-containing) materials will be sent back.



Mercury-containing material



Radioactive material

Radioactive material will be refused under the FANC legislation (Federal Agency for Nuclear Control). The supplier organises the return and/or charging on of shutdown, clean-up and evacuation costs.
